The two new facilities will be adjacent to the new “Center for Intrepid” and are scheduled to be completed in January 2007. Typically, the houses range from 5,000 – 16,000 square feet and designed to provide eight to 21 suites. The houses feature a common kitchen, laundry facilities, spacious dining room a living room with a library, as well as toys for the children. The Fisher Houses are temporary residences and not treatment facilities, hospices or counseling centers.
